ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Latest national test scores show a decline in reading abilities, with two-thirds of 4th and 8th graders below the Proficient level of reading (which means consistently understanding text and interpreting its meaning). Reading skills are necessary for all subjects, especially now in the age of AI.

Meemli helps improve reading capacity for middle schoolers by providing our online “Reading With Friends” program that is easy to access, effective, and also engaging and fun for students.
